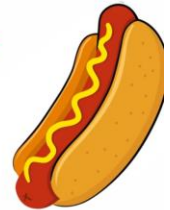

### ***Sock It To Me***



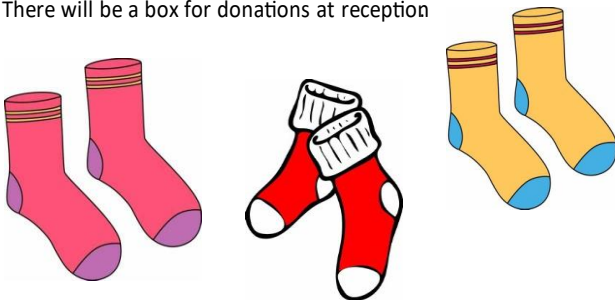
**This winter give a sock to those in need**
