

In 2018 CSPS formed a Make a Difference (MAD) Committee.

Our existing and passionate MAD Committee is looking for new members who drive projects and engage our students in ways to support the broader community with various activities.

In 2022 MAD worked with students and our community with a variety of successful and interesting projects including:

- 1. providing a cake stall at the Welcome Picnic with funds raised for flood victims;
- 2. conducting a footy boot & ball donation drive for Boots for All;
- 3. running a second-hand book stall with JSC supporting flood victims;
- 4. working with EAG to produce 7 student videos on recycling;

- 6. continuing to recycle all textile waste from the second-hand uniform shop; and
- 7. continuing the recycling program at CSPS collecting writing instruments and dental care.

- To fundraise for student nominated charities alongside students at the Welcome Picnic and Twilight Market.
