Last Thursday Jono Watkins, Charlie Lord and I were lucky enough to attend a Numeracy Leaders Network day where we heard from Emeritus Professor Di Siemon as she discussed the big ideas in mathematics. We have been working hard over the past 12 months at CSPS to build problem solving and mathematical reasoning tasks into our teaching and learning program and it was great to hear Di reinforce that we are on the right track. Something that really stood out for me was Di stating that while we often believe as adults, we use maths most when calculating the cost of items at the supermarket, in fact, the biggest skill we draw on daily is the reading and interpreting of numbers relative to context. This skill requires a critical stance, an alertness to context and understanding of numbers. It is these critical thinking skills we are aiming to embed further into our teaching and learning program.

We were unlucky with the weather on Friday for our Year 3-6 Athletics Carnival, however, I'd like to thank all our parent volunteers, staff and particularly Dan Evans who pushed through the adverse weather for as long as possible and then enacted Plan B on very short notice. Dan is ensuring that our students don't miss out on the opportunity to participate in the events by running them back at school.
