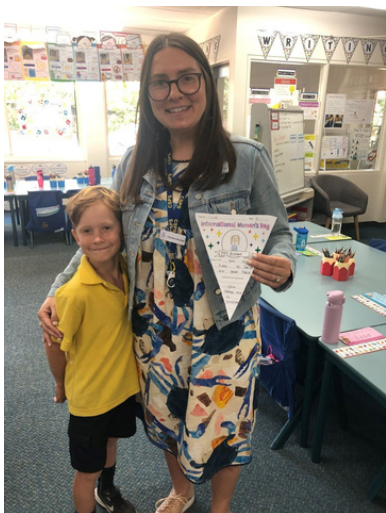

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## MUSIC NEWS

As a part of the Victorian Curriculum, I am required to teach the students cultural music. Where possible I try and choose a culture represented in our school community. Every year, I endeavour to change up the way the cultural music is presented as over a 7 year period it is best to expose students to a variety of approaches. For 2024, I am presenting music and movement/dance connected to celebrations.

To achieve these outcomes, my music classroom sessions will move to the theatre – designed specifically for dance, drama and musical theatre in the 2009 Rudd government financial roll out to build schools.

During Week 7, I am engaging the children in Mexican music/dance cultural studies. The students will hear about Cinco de Mayo (5 May) celebrations:

We will look at the reason for the celebration, dance costume, and learn to do the Mexican Hat Dance to the music. As the family have come to our shores from Mexico, their first hand generous sharing of culture is invaluable as we move through the next few weeks.

During Week 8, I will explore East African music and dance in the theatre – we have Saba who has come to us from East Africa.





Performance groups are open to any student learning an instrument, having an interest and are at the right stage of learning. MT provides work cooperatively in the Music Department to provide extension opportunities.



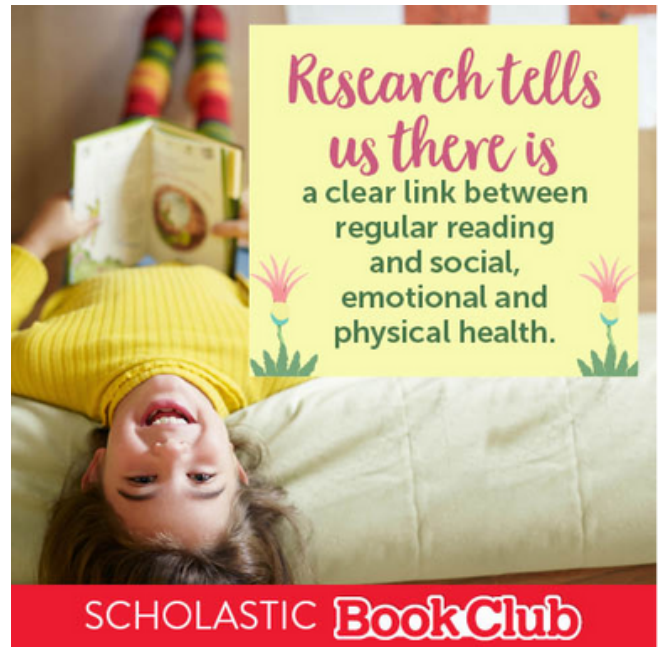
