





Class and Ensembles


Performance groups are open to any student learning an instrument, having an interest and are at the right stage of learning. IMT programs were delivered by the Music Department to provide extension opportunities.

Following her professional dance career Kate has been teaching, coaching, choreographing and running dance related programs for primary schools and local communities in Australia and UK.


